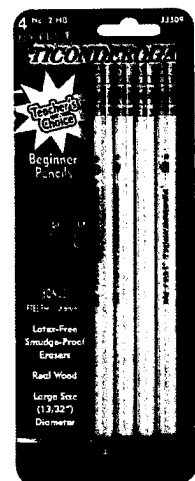


# Welcome to Kindergarten!

- 1 pack of "My First" Ticonderoga pencils. (The perfect oversized beginner pencil ::large size 13/32 Inch Diameter::)

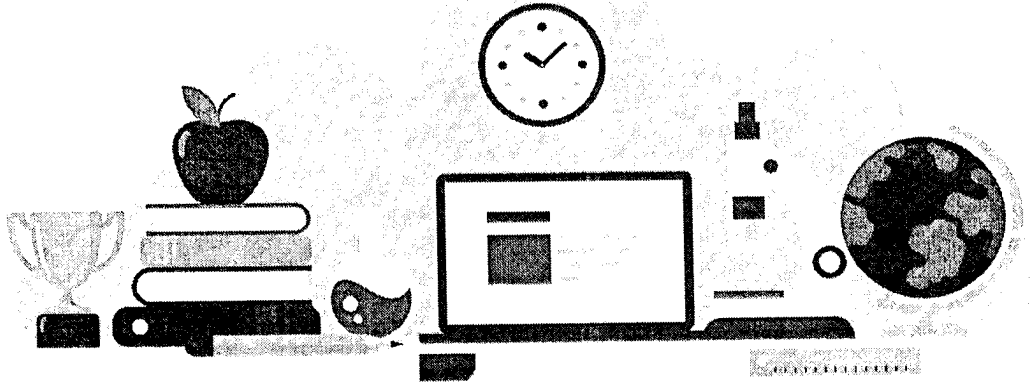




# First Grade Supply List

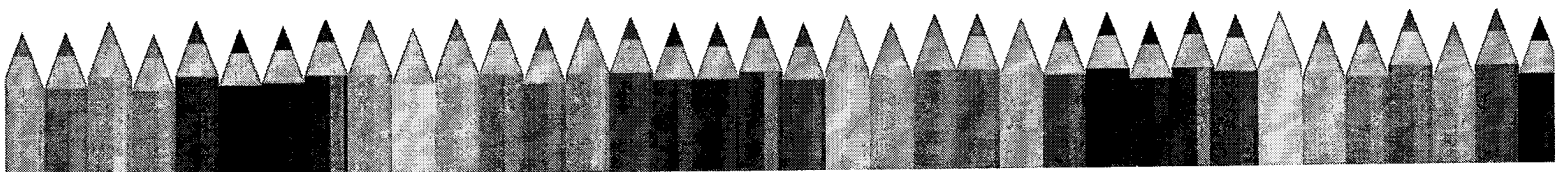
## Supply List for 2017-2018

**For all classes:**

**English—Grades 7-8:**

- 2 inch + three ring binder (stays in class)
- 2 pocket folders (one for class, one for homework)
- 2 packs +Lined paper, preferably college rule
- insertable binder dividers (8 tabs in pack)
- 2 glue sticks
- notecards
- highlighters
- red pens
- insertable pencil pouch
- pencil sharpener
- 1 pack dry erase markers with eraser\*
- sanitizing wipes\*
- hand sanitizer\*
- tissue\*

\*The final four supplies will be shared in the classroom, but everything else will be the individual student's responsibility to have and keep in class each day. The binder will be used as an organizational tool and will be part of a class grade throughout the year.

**English—Grades 9-12:**

- 1- Notebook (any size/design appropriate for notes and written assignments, college ruled preferred)  
OR 1 – 1" Binder and packet of lined paper (college ruled preferred)
- 1- folder with pockets
- 1- box of Kleenex
- Dry erase markers (NOT black)
- 1- set of highlighters: 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 blue, 1 pink or purple
- Post-its (multicolored preferred)
- 2 independent reading novels/books that interest you, either fiction or non-fiction, (can be borrowed from the library) for personal reading

**Math**

- 1- 5 subject notebook
- 1- TI 83/TI 84 Graphing calculator (**for HS grade levels**)
- 1- binder
- 12- binder dividers
- 1- Folder

**Science:**

- Lab manual (Found at Walmart—approximately 50 cents a piece)
- 1- Box of Kleenex
- 1- Box of Colored pencils
- 1- Pair of Scissors
- 4- Glue sticks
- Any old magazines (for cutting up—you will not get them back)
- 1- Green folder with pocket(s)

**Social Studies:**

- 1 - 5-Subject Notebook OR 1 - 1" Binder (student will be responsible for paper)
- 4 - plain 2-pocket folders (1 for each quarter)
- 3 - boxes of Kleenex OR 1- hand sanitizer
- 4 - Dry erase markers (Black/Blue)

**Notes:**

\*Students in grades 9-12 will be provided with an assigned computer and should have a safe way to transport their computer from class to class, as students are responsible for damages to their assigned computer. **A backpack or type of messenger bag/satchel is an appropriate way to transport school items and keep all materials safe.**
